Intermunicipal cooperation and expertise The best practices and case studies of Inter-Municipal Concepts IMC in this regard aim to address and foster specifically new or already running intermunicipal cooperations, and aim to enhance the expertise and decision-making capacities of public authorities by providing them with tools and concepts for IMC, in connection with the prospect of Regional Closed Loop Economies RCLE. A renewed and sustainable building sector in the Alps The overall aim is to thereby show to different actors and groups concerned with planning and construction, and to a general public, how to valorize the potential of Alpine Building Culture in territorial development, and how to specifically enhance intermunicipal background conditions for a more sustainable and added-value

<p>Results (max 1.000 characters)</p>	<p>oriented setup of the building sector in the Alps.</p> <p>The developed and applied guideline for analysis and setup of Inter-Municipal Concepts provides a transferable framework for planning oriented towards building culture values, and including energy and regional economy issues. According to the different policy and planning background, tools and processes of analysis and planning have been adapted to the AlpBC approach of IMC, and have been related to regional economies in the construction sector. This project-inherent testing and evaluating of adapted approaches constitutes one of the unique education and communication contents of the AlpHouse Centers (WP 7), and has been spread in the series of regional symposia (WP 8) - together with the collection of evaluated good practices and supportive case studies of IMCs. In the results especially a transferable guideline and SWOT-tool for potential and inclusion of Regional Closed Loop Economies RCLE in the building sector is ready for transfer, and will improve regional competitiveness.</p>
<p>Unexpected success stories (max 1.000 characters)</p>	<p>Valle d'Aosta (IT) COA Energia Finaosta S.p.A. in cooperation regional public and private partners has implemented in the Italian case study Valle d'Aosta...</p> <p>Achental (DE) For the German case study Achental, the partners Chamber of Crafts and Leibniz Universität Hannover developed "Gemeindedialoge" as transferable tool to improve regional expertise of public bodies, private construction firms and planners, and of citizens. An innovative form of "market of ideas" merge the specific and different needs of the municipalities, their decision-making and financial possibilities. In this process cooperations between the municipalities regarding single spatial themes. The overall concept of enlarging cooperation and impact of the association Ökomodell (9 municipalities) with the 3 additional cooperating municipalities, in addressing planning and building as important part of sustainability, environment and energy issues. The tool has been implemented with a workshop, that responded to the analyzed strategic thematic focusses for the region, structured in: Sustainable and energetic Strategies related to territorial development, local development and landscape, local materials and innovative technologies.</p>
