Results and outcomes (use cases):

Description:

- The community of Schleching initiated the association, setting the goal of becoming a sustainable community. To become more effective, more and more communities in the Achental region joined in. Today, nine communities are involved.
 - Preservation of natural and cultural landscape / Protection of agricultural businesses and regional product marketing / Supporting and developing sustainable tourism and trade / Increased use of renewable energies from the region for the region.
 - Every community is obliged to act according to a charta.
- The association consists of nine communities. The board consists of the mayors of these communities and 5 external experts, lead by the mayor of Schleching as the chairman. The board meets once a month for exchange and strategy discussion. To achieve consent, bottom-up and top-down principles are both used.

Relevance for inter-municipal planning (AlpBC):

- The Ökomodell Achental e.V. encourages a holistic approach for the main stakeholders of the region, the citizens and politicians. Networking across disciplines and technical authorities supports a coordinated strategy in the Achental region according to the association goals.
- The Ökomodell advances and develops energy supply from the region for the region, while carefully considering agriculture and land use as well as national parks and recreation.
- Serving as a mediator through support of various products from different sectors to balance energy goals, nature preservation and regional production.
- Goals are monitored regularly and success of the individual projects is evaluated these results can be incorporated into spatial planning.
- The contribution consist in a more indirect way through sensitizing stakeholders and decision makers early in the overall planning process.
- SMEs are supported in knowledge building by information exchange, financial incentives and integration into the regions 'goals.
- Innovative materials and techniques are advanced and promoted in all of the Ökomodell projects.

Relevance for policy goals (Alpine Space, Europe and the region):

- The Ökomodell approach shows that a local partner initiative for carrying out and processing innovations, ideas and techniques is irreplaceable as it can react to specific regional conditions.
